An initiative born in 2006 from the School of Public Health and Community Medicine at the University of New South Wales, Football United creates chances for youth from disadvantaged communities. Brought together through the magic of football, Football United programs engage and inspire young people through life skills and leadership education along with the delivery of free, easily accessible and regular football, in schools and communities. Since 2014 Football United operates in partnership with the Creating Chances social enterprise it co-founded, providing internationally and nationally renowned best practice, evidence-based programs promoting positive youth development through sport.











About the Program

Between February - March 2022, Football United will be hosting the third Sportswomen for Change Leadership Program supported by the Commonwealth through the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade's Council for Australian-Arab Relations. The 6-week virtual leadership program will foster inclusion and cross-cultural exchange of 20 emerging leaders in sport to champion sports for social change between Australia and Arab regions.

The program will provide emerging female leaders a sophisticated virtual learning experience with access to expert facilitators and the tools to develop creative solutions and positive change in their communities.

Exchange


Participants will expand their network and collaborate to understand different cultures and exchange knowledge and ideas in sport for social change.



Application Selection Criteria

- Emerging female leaders, aged between 18-30 years old
- Committed to advocating for sport as a vehicle for social change
- Currently participate, volunteer or work with an organisation or club as an administrator, coach, mentor, referee, or athlete
- Interested in getting to know other people from different backgrounds and developing new skills
- Willing to share your own experiences and knowledge about how your organisation/project uses sport as a tool to promote positive social change through online discussions, workshops and team building activities
- Available for the duration of the program and be able to communicate via internet leading up to the forum
- Commit to ongoing communication and contribute to the network after the forum
- Strong English communication skills





Timeline

Successful Applicants informed: Early Jan








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The program will run over 6 weeks, 2 sessions per week, and each session will be approximately 2 hours.
